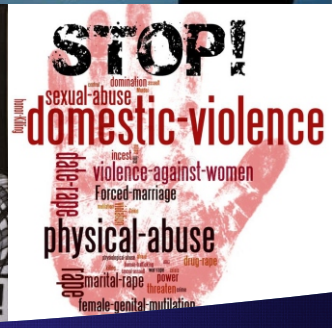

**One Stop Centre (OSC):** One Stop Centre (OSC) is exclusively designed to support women in distress facing violence or threat of violence both in private and public spaces including in the family, community and workplace. The centre is open 24x7 and renders services to aggrieved women even during the Covid-19 pandemic lockdown.

One Stop Centre also provides medical assistance, legal aid, police assistance, psycho-social support/counseling, rescue and shelter.

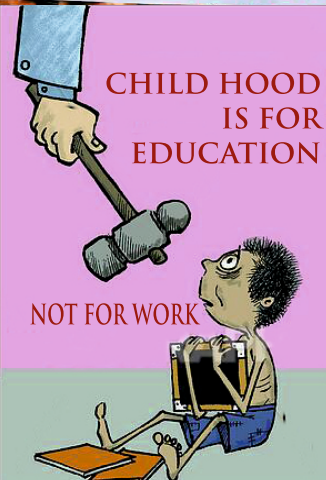

- Holiday cannot be declared on any working day, except in any cases of local urgency, subject to prior permission of concerned District Addl./Joint Directors and holidays, so declared should be compensated by adjusting the working hours of the school compulsorily.
- 11<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Saturdays will be holidays and other Saturdays will be treated as half working days.
- All the co-curricular activities should be conducted in the second half or on half working days.
- Lessons in Law to be taught to Classes IX & X students as a Co-curricular Subject. (Not more than two periods/week/class).
- School Timing from 09.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. to be followed by all the Schools mandatorily. Syllabi to be completed at least 15 days before 1<sup>st</sup> Term and 2<sup>nd</sup> Term Examinations respectively. Remaining periods to be utilised for revision.
- School timing w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021 till the last academic working day shall be from 09:15am till 03:30pm.
- Total No. of Working Days for the Academic Session 2021=219 days.
- School reopens on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2022 (Monday).
