MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE HIGH POWERED COMMITTEE HELD ON 29th April, 2025 THROUGH VIRTUAL MODE

A meeting of the High Powered Committed chaired by Hon'ble Mrs Justice Meenakshi Madan Rai, Judge, High Court of Sikkim and Executive Chairperson, Sikkim SLSA/Chairperson, High Powered Committee was held on 29.04.2025 (*Tuesday*) through virtual mode.

Additionally, they receive regular visits from:

- 1. Dr Tsepel Eden Bhutia, Psychiatrist (twice in a month).
- 2. Dr Ganesh Rai (OST), monthly.
- 3. Eye Technician Jitendra Basnett, monthly.

Item Agenda No 6:

Continuation of sanitization and maintenance of hygiene and cleanliness in the State Central Prison, Rongyek, East Sikkim and District Prison, Boomtar, Namchi, South Sikkim.

As informed by the State Central Prison vide letter bearing No 44/SCP/JAIL/2025 dated 21.04.2025, sanitization in the Prison is being carried out once in a month instead of fortnightly as resolved by the High Powered Committee on 11.12.2024.

As informed by the District Prison, Boomtar vide letter bearing No 59/DPN/2025 dated 21.04.2025, sanitization in the District Prison is being carried out on a fortnightly basis.

Cleanliness including sweeping, mopping, checking beddings of the UTPs in both the Prisons are being carried out on a regular basis.

The Secretary, Home Department, undertakes to ensure that the sanitization at the Prisons, especially the State Central Prison, Rongyek is carried out on a fortnightly basis, as already resolved at the previous meeting of the High Powered Committee held on 11th December, 2024.

Vide letters bearing 44/SCP/JAIL/2025 dated 21.04.2025 and 59/DPN/2025 dated 21.04.2025, received from State Central Prison, Rongyek and District Prison, Boomtar, respectively, it has been informed that all the UTPs required for remand are being produced only through Video Conferencing and UTPs undergoing trial are being produced physically before the Ld Courts.

Item Agenda No 9:

Steps taken for and progress of counselling of UTPs and Convicts by Psychologists and Psychiatrists at the State Central Prison, Rongyek, East Sikkim and District Prison, Boomtar, Namchi, South Sikkim (UTPs, Convicts under SADA and UTPs, Convicts with mental illness, other UTPs and Convicts in need of counselling)

As informed by the State Central Prison, Rongyek, Psychiatrist is visiting the State Central Prison, Rongyek on a fortnightly basis, and, the Clinical Psychologist is visiting the prison as and when required.

On query by the Hon'ble Chairperson, High Powered Committee, it was informed by the Additional Superintendent of Police (Prison), District Prison, Boomtar that virtual counseling sessions for the UTPs under Section SADA and NDPS is being carried out by Serenity Home, Gangtok on weekly basis. That, Sanjeevani Rehabilitation Centre, Namchi district has not conducted such counseling sessions in the Prison.
